FRUIT FOR THE FAIR.

NOVA SCOTIA APPLES WILL BE DISPLAYED IN

STANDARD AT CHICAGO.

HALIFAX, November 7.—The Nova

Scotia Fruit Growers' Association have

sent to Chicago for cold storage upwards

of two hundred varieties of apples and

pears put up in as many different cases.

The association will keep a small quantity

of fruit constantly between the big ex-

hibition, and as these become worn out

on account of decay, they will be replaced

by fresh supplies from the same which will

be left in cold storage.

The Dominion government bears the

cost of transportation, while the care of

the fruit will be undertaken by the managers

of the World's Fair.
